March 2-6, 2009	STM101 Stratmodel	(5 day course) \$3,000	Drill hole import and interrogation, schema definitions, general modeling concepts, stratmodel graphics, quality modeling, reserves.
April 1-3, 2009	OCPLAN101 Open Cut Layout	(3 day course) \$1,800	Long and Short range planning utilizing MineScape. Surface manipulations, working with pit survey data, surface projections, ultimate pit construction, long term mine layout, reserve reporting, output to Scheduling.
April 6-10, 2009	SCHED101 Introduction to Schedule	(5 day course) \$3,000	New project setup, block record definition, machine definitions, calendar definitions, summary reports, interactive scheduling.
May 4-8, 2009	MSCP401 MineScape for New Hires	(5 day course) \$3,000	New project setup, overall menu functionality, GTI CAD, grid files, table files, surfaces, reports, reserves, plotting, triangulation.
